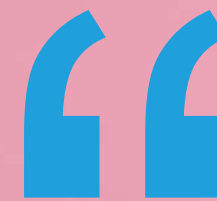
The **Care Development Project (CDP)** delivers accessible, fully-funded training and career development opportunities for the social care sector in Liverpool City Region.

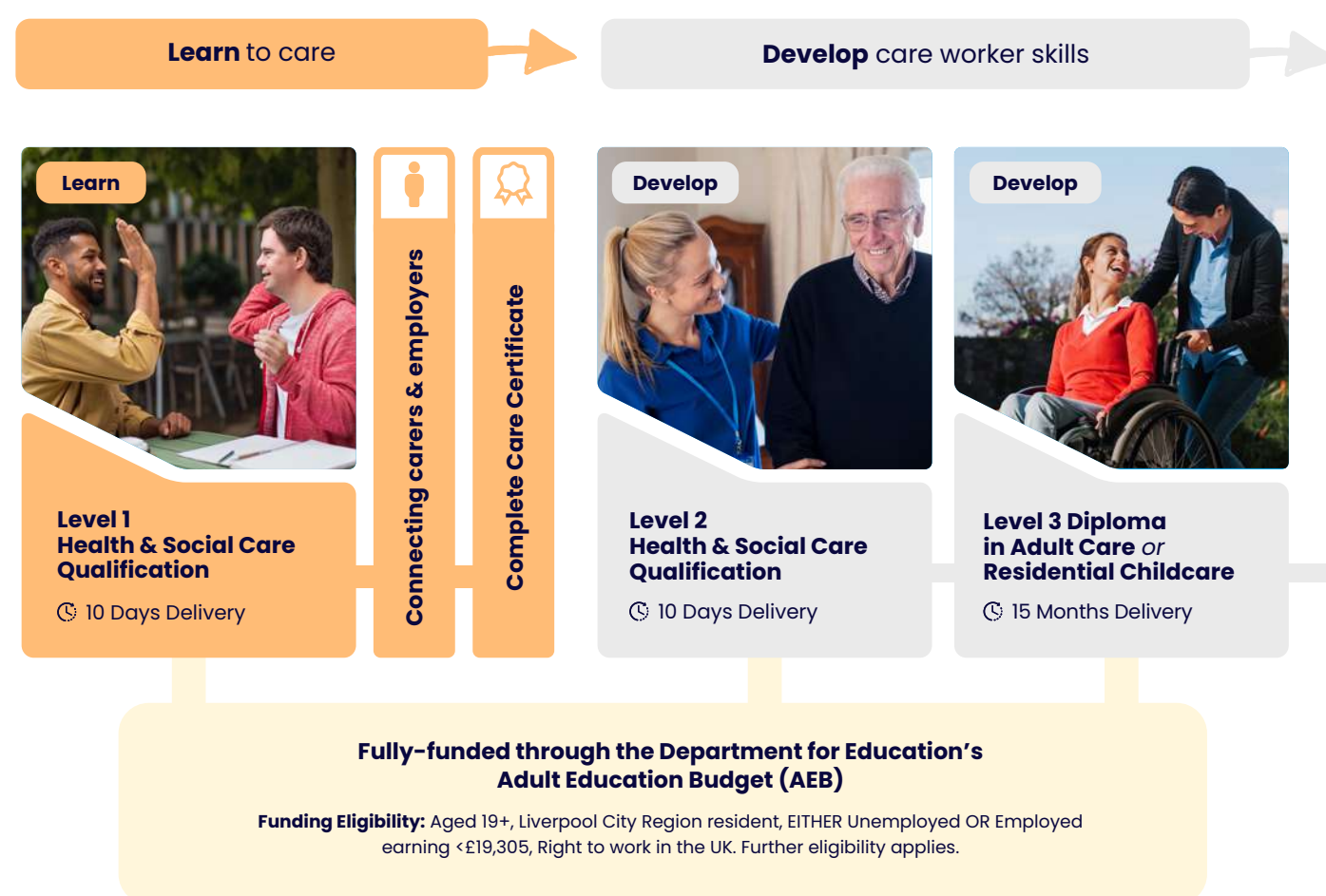

Programme Pathways.



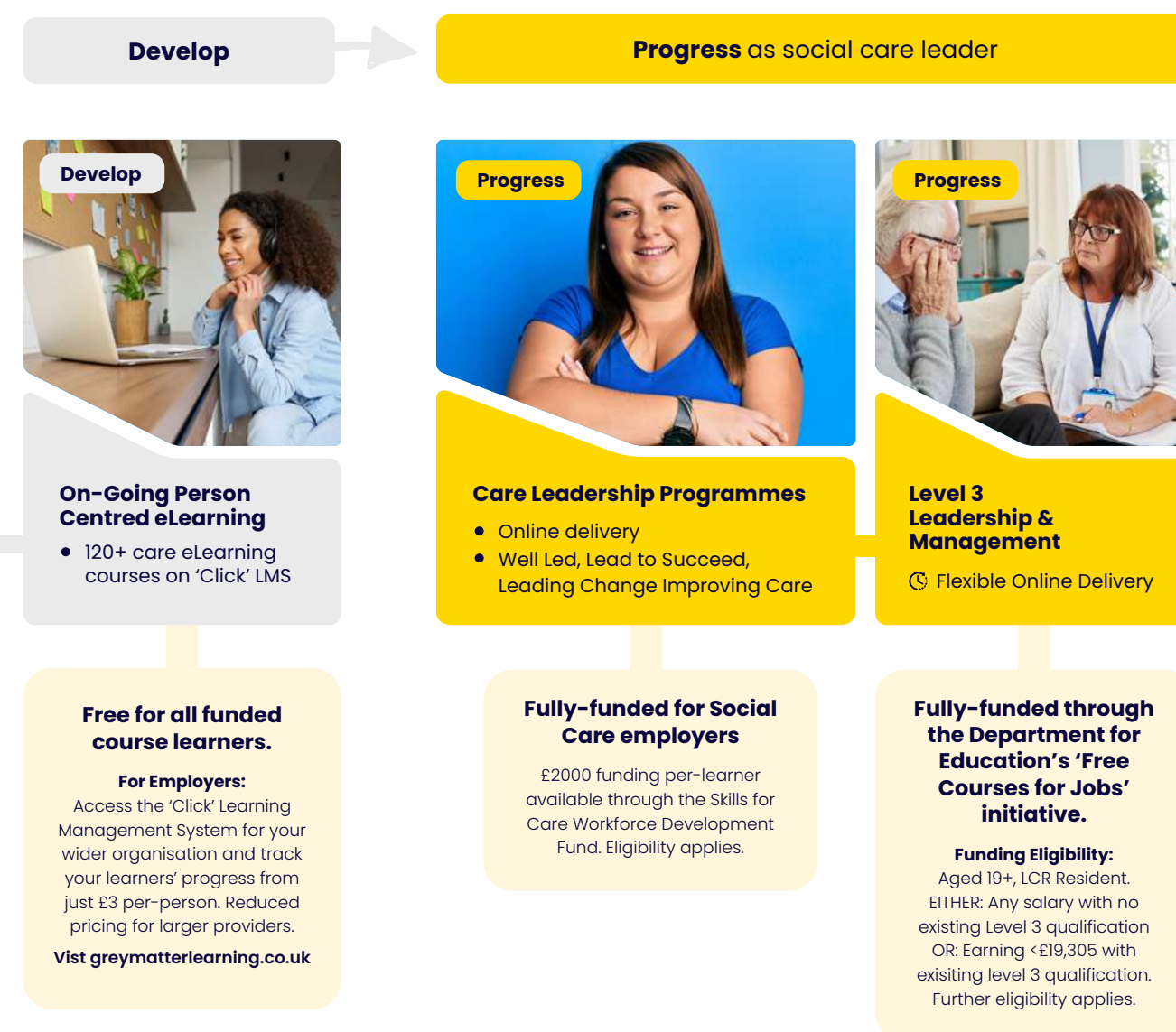
